Coaches shared what it looks like in their programs. Sometimes it is about the coach knowing the goal and noting when they see it then having a conversation with the coach when they can. It is sometimes less formal especially in Child Care programs when staff and time are limited

We took a poll to see where everyone was at with coaching. No judgements just wanted to know where barriers might be and what else coaches may need to do the work. Celebration of the work happening!!

- 73% of coaches attending are following the coaching cycle
- 89% have done 1-2 cycles since September
- 18% have done 2 or more

We looked at what a focused observation may look like and reviewed one form to use to record your observations.

- helpful to write down what the observation is focusing on
- Helpful to record what the teacher did/said
- Share with the teacher how the child/children responded.

Discussion was had about what to do when a goal is met or if it wasn't met or partially met why this might be and then what does the conversation look like for that.
