Endorsement for Culturally Sensitive, Relationship-Focused Practice Promoting Infant Mental Health® is an internationally established credential that supports and recognizes professionals who work with or on behalf of infants, toddlers, and their families. It's the largest IMH credentialing system in the United States and it's available to you here in Wisconsin! Individuals across disciplines such as early care and education, home visiting, health care, public health, child welfare, and mental health may be eligible to apply.

The IMH-E Competencies® provide the framework from which IMH-Endorsement® was developed. To earn Endorsement an applicant demonstrates acquisition and application of the competencies through education, training and work experiences.

Please use it when attending training or other professional development offerings that address the needs and capacities of infants, young children and families. 4 simple steps to starting the IMH-Endorsement® Application process!

1. Determine which Endorsement Category at which to apply:

2. Become a WI-AIMH Member:

Membership to an IMH association is required for Endorsement®. You will be asked to provide your IMH Association membership number upon registration. We hope you chose WI-AIMH as your professional home! Go to <http://wiaimh.org/get-involved/membership/> to become a member of WI-AIMH; we offer individual membership (\$60/year) and organizational membership (\$320/year) for up to 8 staff people.

3. Complete Endorsement® Registration:

Go to <http://easy.mi-aimh.org/wi-aimh> to register. Click on *Register* under *New Applicant and complete all the fields*. Please have information about your educational background, work experience, and reflective supervision (including total number of hours received) available when you register.

4. Complete Payment:

Pay the \$20 registration fee.

Once your registration information is reviewed and accepted by WI-AIMH, the Endorsement® Application System (EASy) will automatically generate an email to you with your username and temporary password and WI-AIMH will send you a welcome letter, with instructions on setting your EASy password and user options.
